Funky Fest-2019

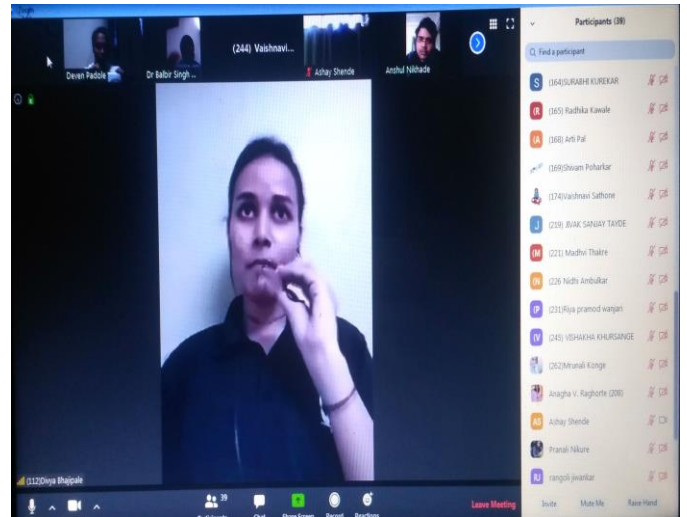
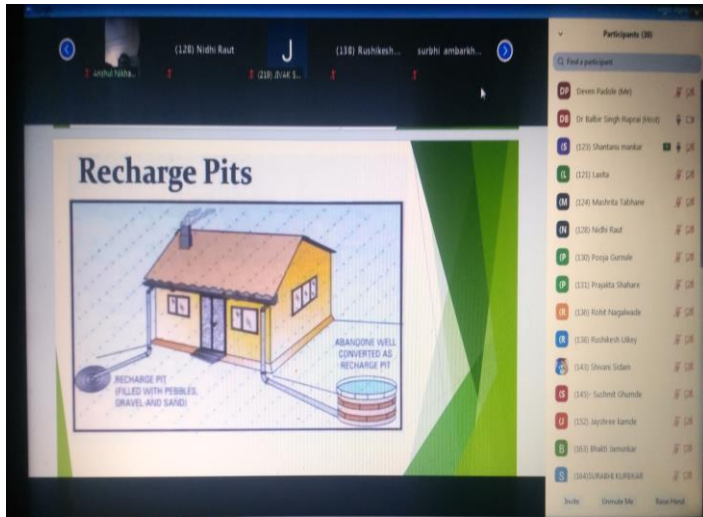

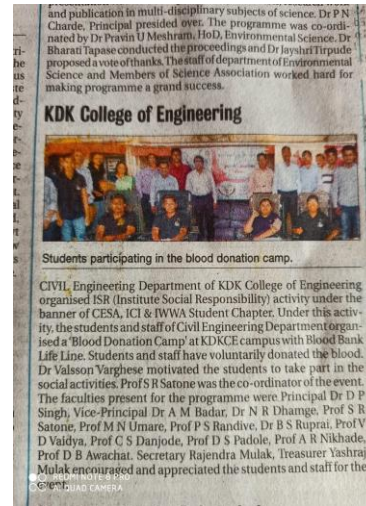
