onsider the various demands made on your project. In carrying out a project, sales personnel, schedulers, MRP controllers and buyers all require different data. With SAP's Project System (PS), you can use existing data and organizational structures, such as cost center hierarchies, purchasing organizations or work center hierarchies, to organize your project.

Use the integrated applications of the R/3 System to meet your project-specific needs: sales orders for the sales division, work breakdown structures for project management, networks and activities for


schedule monitoring and capacity planning, bills of material for production and purchasing.

PLANNING: CLEAR AND SIMPLE

The user-friendly graphical interface helps you to create work breakdown structures, networks or Gantt charts both quickly and easily.

Use simple planning structures for rough-cut planning, for example, and create a plan with costs and dates using the work breakdown structure. You can expand this plan or even combine it with other planning methods, at any time, to optimize your resources. Plan your costs by cost element or carry out unit costing. Precise dates and the critical path are determined for you in scheduling.

You can plan your resources with help from the other applications in the R/3 System, for example, purchasing, inventory management and capacity planning. Using a network, you can plan labor, capacity, operating resources and services required for the project. SAP's Project System automatically creates the purchase requisitions and reserves the required materials.






RESOURCES AVAILABLE WHEN YOU NEED THEM

Project System automatically checks and controls that funds, capacities, and/or materials will be available when vou need them. Budget management helps you save money by controlling the allocated and approved budget and by checking whether the necessary funds are available for each resource assigned to the project. For example, if you go over budget with a purchase order, the system automatically sends a message via SAPmail® to the project manager. Capacity requirements planning keeps track of the required capacities, so you can respond quickly to bottlenecks or rescheduling. The system can even check whether the material is there before you go ahead with assembly.

INFORMATION WITH A CAPITAL "I"

The Information System within the Project System enables you to design the layout and level of detail of your evaluations and reports. With the Information System you have up-to-theminute project data. You get the data you require the way you want it: in list or graphical form for actual and planned costs, revenues, open items, schedules, and resources. Whether you use the standard SAP evaluations or create your own customized reports, you have constant access to the most current data.



PROJECT SYSTEM SHARES INFORMATION

Haven't you always wanted to be able to download data from your project and use it for other projects and calculations? The Project System offers communication channels to MS Project and MS Excel. You can also exchange data electronically with customers and vendors through the SAP-EDI® interface in R/3 applications SD (Sales and Distribution) and MM (Materials Management).
