

WINDOWS 9x/ME SHORTCUT KEYS

As a technician, there are many times when you'll need to navigate in the Windows 9x/Me environment without the benefit of a working mouse or other pointing device. When this happens, you'll need to rely on the keyboard equivalents or shortcuts, which are shown below.

WINDOWS SYSTEM KEYS

| | |
|----------------|---|
| F1 | Opens Help |
| CTRL-ESC | Opens Start menu |
| ALT-TAB | Switches between open programs |
| ALT-F4 | Quits program |
| SHIFT-DELETE | Deletes item permanently |
| F10 | Activates menu bar options |
| SHIFT-F10 | Opens a shortcut menu for the selected item (this is the same as right-clicking an object) |
| CTRL-ESC | Opens the Start menu (use the ARROW keys to select an item) |
| ESC | Selects the Start button (press TAB to select the taskbar, or press SHIFT-F10 for a context menu) |
| ALT-DOWN ARROW | Opens a drop-down list box |
| ALT-TAB | Switches to another running program (hold down the ALT key and then press the TAB key to view the task-switching window) |
| SHIFT | Bypasses the automatic-run feature when you press and hold down the SHIFT key while inserting a CD-ROM |
| ALT-SPACE | Displays the main window's System menu (from the System menu, you can restore, move, resize, minimize, maximize, or close the window) |

WINDOWS PROGRAM KEYS

|--------|-----------|
| CTRL-C | Copy |
| CTRL-X | Cut |
| CTRL-V | Paste |
| CTRL-Z | Undo |
| CTRL-B | Bold |
| CTRL-U | Underline |
| CTRL-I | Italic |

KEYBOARD MODIFIERS

| | |
|--------------------|---|
| SHIFT-right-click | Displays a shortcut menu containing alternative commands |
| SHIFT-double-click | Runs the alternate default command (the second item on the menu) |
| ALT-double-click | Displays properties |
| SHIFT-DELETE | Deletes an item immediately without placing it in the Recycle Bin |

GENERAL FOLDER/WINDOWS EXPLORER SHORTCUTS

| | |
|--------------------------|---|
| F2 | Renames object |
| F3 | Finds all files |
| CTRL-X | Cut |
| CTRL-C | Copy |
| CTRL-V | Paste |
| SHIFT-DELETE | Deletes selection immediately, without moving the item to the Recycle Bin |
| ALT-ENTER | Opens the properties for the selected object |
| F4 | Selects the Go To A Different Folder box and moves down the entries in the box (if the toolbar is active in Windows Explorer) |
| F5 | Refreshes the current window |
| F6 | Moves among panes in Windows Explorer |
| CTRL-G | Opens the Go To Folder tool (in Windows 95 Windows Explorer only) |
| CTRL-Z | Undoes the last command |
| CTRL-A | Selects all the items in the current window |
| BACKSPACE | Switches to the parent folder |
| SHIFT-CLICK-CLOSE button | For folders, closes the current folder plus all parent folders |

ACCESSIBILITY SHORTCUTS

|---|----------------------------------|
| Press SHIFT five times | Toggles StickyKeys on and off |
| Press down and hold the right SHIFT key for eight seconds | Toggles FilterKeys on and off |
| Press down and hold the NUM LOCK key for five seconds | Toggles ToggleKeys on and off |
| Left ALT-left SHIFT-NUM LOCK | Toggles MouseKeys on and off |
| Left ALT-left SHIFT-PRINSCREEN | Toggles high contrast on and off |

MICROSOFT NATURAL KEYBOARD KEYS

| | |
|-----------------------|--|
| Windows Logo | Opens Start menu |
| Windows Logo-R | Opens Run dialog box |
| Windows Logo-M | Minimizes all |
| SHIFT-Windows Logo-M | Undoes Minimize All command |
| Windows Logo-F1 | Opens Help |
| Windows Logo-E | Opens Windows Explorer |
| Windows Logo-F | Finds files or folders |
| Windows Logo-D | Minimizes all open windows and displays the desktop |
| CTRL-Windows Logo-F | Finds computer |
| CTRL-Windows Logo-TAB | Moves focus from Start to the Quick Launch toolbar to the system tray (use RIGHT ARROW or LEFT ARROW to move focus to items on the Quick Launch toolbar and the system tray) |
| Windows Logo-TAB | Cycles through taskbar buttons |
| Windows Logo-BREAK | Opens System Properties dialog box |
| Application key | Displays a shortcut menu for the selected item |

DIALOG BOX KEYBOARD COMMANDS

| | |
|-----------|---|
| TAB | Moves to the next control in the dialog box |
| SHIFT-TAB | Moves to the previous control in the dialog box |
| SPACEBAR | If the current control is a button, this clicks the button. If the current control is a check box, this toggles the check box. If the current control is an option, this selects the option |
| ENTER | Equivalent to clicking the selected button (button with the outline) |
| ESC | Equivalent to clicking the Cancel button |
